Album: A Hard Day's Night **Date:** 1964

Paul McCartney wrote this about his girlfriend, an actress named Jane Asher. For a while, they were the most popular couple in England. After they broke up in 1968, McCartney married Linda Eastman and Asher became a proficient author. She runs her own business called "Jane Asher Party Cakes."

This was one of the first pop songs with a title that starts in mid-sentence.

Paul McCartney was the only Beatle to sing on this. Like "Yesterday," it is one of just of few Beatle songs with only 1 vocalist.

This was originally not intended to be a ballad. The take on The Beatles **Anthology 1** is much faster and includes both drums and George's 12-string electric guitar.
