



## OPEN ACCESS POLICY

(Approved by the Governing Council of the University of Murcia on 2nd October 2020)

The publishing house of University of Murcia (EDITUM) establishes its open access policy along with the foundations stated in Open Science international commands in order to contribute the transmission of knowledge and investigations results and declares that:

EDITUM publishes a wide catalogue of open access magazines (<http://revistas.um.es>) and books (<http://libros.um.es>) that are available through their website <http://editum.um.es>.

The published contents shall be the publishing house version and any other previous version shall be published in open access.

**TYPES OF BOOKS.** Any monographic work (manuals, educational material, reports, prizes, tributes, etc.) that fulfil the same academic and scientific quality requirements than the printed versions shall be published in open access.

**AUTHORS.** Publication of open access material helps to discover them and their immediate use. Those publications that both the publishing house and the author consider shall have two open access publication options:

- Immediate access to the whole document
- Mediate access to the document for a period of time that may vary between 6 and 12 months.

The author shall keep the moral rights over the work and shall be able to decide whether the publication shall be published in open access or for a period of time of 12 months or is the printed version out of stock.

The author shall leave the editor version in any repository or academic social network for open access publications. University of Murcia shall leave a copy in the institutional repository, DIGITUM.

Every publication that was supported with public funds shall be published in open access with no limit of time, as it is stated in the Spanish Law 14/2011, of 1st July, on Science, Technology, and Innovation.

Some benefits that the author gets from the open access are the increasing visibility of their work and its immediate spreading but refusing the economic benefits that may receive for them.

**IDENTIFICATION.** Every document spread in open access have a DOI number. Any work published in open access shall have an ISBN number property of the publishing house.



**LICENSE.** Every work spread in open access shall be published under the license Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International (CC BY).

**CONTRACT.** The author and the publishing house shall sign a publication contract for every work spread in open access. Said contract must state the terms and conditions agreed and must establish the rights and duties of both parties.
