

## **CONTINGENCY PLAN OF THE FACULTY OF PHILOSOPHY FOR THE PREVENTION OF INFECTION BY COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS**

Following the instructions of the COVID-19 Monitoring Committee of the University of Murcia, the following measures are adopted, the temporal scope of which will be marked by the rector's resolutions which, in turn, will be determined by the regional and state guidelines.

In order to minimize the impact of academic unemployment and to favor the autonomous learning of the students of the Faculty of Philosophy, this deanship has provided the following:

Regarding the official teachings:

- The classes of the Master of Research in Philosophy will continue to be held by video-conference as usual.
- The teaching staff will establish a plan of alternative activities to the face-to-face classes for each subject of the Degree in Philosophy
- The direction of End of Degree and Master's projects will continue through the virtual classroom, e-mail, etc.
- Alternative methods of theoretical and practical evaluation will be programmed for those Erasmus, Sicue... students who decide to suspend their stay outside UMU, and for those exchange students at UMU who decide to return to their place of residence. To facilitate the process, they must inform the Vice-Dean of Students ([agarcia@um.es](mailto:agarcia@um.es)) and the corresponding teaching staff of the change in their situation.
- Students will be provided with material and resources for autonomous learning - bibliography, scripts and summaries of topics with Powerpoint presentations or similar
- Assessable work will be designed as an alternative to practical classroom activities.
- Virtual tutoring will be maintained and an extensive consultation schedule will be established.
- It is advisable to use the tools of the Aula Virtual - chats, forums, videoconference - to establish a relationship with the students and to announce possible group activities.
- It is advisable to consider recording classes or teaching in streaming via the virtual classroom video conference.

The Vice-rectorate of Studies has announced that it is studying possible changes in the academic calendar that would affect the second term, the call for exams and the defence of Final Project (TF).

The university facilities will remain closed until further notice.

It is also agreed:

- To keep the official date of the Philosophy Festival on April 24, provided the authorities allow it. The organizers have been advised to postpone the cultural and leisure activities planned for Thursday 23 April.

- To maintain for the time being the date of the Graduation Ceremony, provided that the authorities allow it.

### **ATTENTION TO DIVERSITY**
