



EUniWell PhD Workshop 2023- Call for Papers

The International Graduate School of the University of Murcia (EIDUM: <https://www.um.es/web/eidum/english>) organizes the First EUniWell PhD Workshop on June 26th-28th (<https://www.um.es/en/web/eidum/actividades/jornadas-doctorales/2023>). The objective is to bring together PhD students and young scholars to present ongoing projects and exchange ideas in any of the EUniWell research areas.

The workshop will be celebrated as a satellite event within the *8th Doctoral Students Conference* of the University of Murcia, Technical University of Cartagena and Campus Mare Nostrum in the form of four special sessions on Well-being and Health (Arena 1), Individual & Social Well-being (Arena 2), Environment, Urbanity and Well-being (Arena 3) and Teacher Education (Arena 4).

For local students participating in general sessions the conference will be onsite. For EUniWell students, their participation in the Workshop thematic panel(s) will be online, with each presentation followed by a discussion by a senior scholar fostering debate, lasting a total of 20 minutes (15 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for discussion). The official language at EUniWell special sessions is English and the participation is free for students from the Alliance.

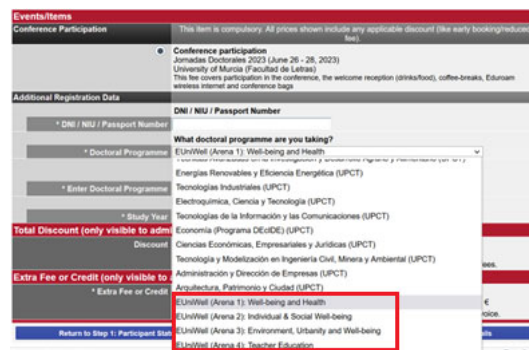


2. Register as student of University of Murcia, Technical University of Cartagena, as student of the EUniWell Alliance or any other university

You may now submit a contribution for the Jornadas Doctorales 2023. Please choose the session you want to contribute to. Before submitting an abstract, please have a look at the Call for Papers on the conference website, where you will find detailed descriptions of all the different sessions and submission types.
There is a limit of 2 contributions per person (one as an author, one as an co-author).
The deadline for the submission of abstracts will be **25th May, 2023**.

- COMUNICACIONES/PAPERS**
Individual papers are formal presentations on original research by one or more authors, lasting a total of 15 minutes (10 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for discussion). Please note that the time limit will be strictly adhered to. The length of abstracts for individual papers is max 800 words. The topic selected from the list must be the Doctoral Programme where the candidate is registered.
- The EUnWell Thematic Panels constitute several independent presentations in English on one of the four Areas of the Alliance and a subsequent joint discussion, lasting a total of 20 minutes (15 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for discussion). They are organized by EIDUM as a complementary satellite activity in collaboration with national and/or international institutions. The length of abstracts is also max 800 words. The topic selected must be one of the following:
EUnWell (Area 1) Well-being and Health
EUnWell (Area 2) Individual & Social Well-being
EUnWell (Area 3) Environment, Urbanity and Well-being
EUnWell (Area 4) Teacher Education
Deadline: 25th May 2023, 11:59:59pm CEST. Time left: 32 days 3 hours
- POSTERS** **only allowed for face-to-face attendees**
Poster sessions are for displaying research and they offer the opportunity for individualized informal discussions. Poster is a good format for presenting work-in-progress, feedback and results of empirical research when data can be presented visually (e.g. charts, graphs, tables). A block of time will be designated when presenters are available to discuss their posters. The length of abstracts for posters is max 800 words.
